### Project Description

Zomba Central Hospital (ZCH) is one of the 3 central hospitals in Malawi and has a capacity of 328 beds. The original hospital was built some 100 years ago, most present buildings date back from the 1930s. Due to age and lack of maintenance the buildings are in very poor condition.

For the improvement of ZCH at long term, a comprehensive Rehabilitation Programme has been introduced. This programme foresees the increase of the Hospital's ward capacity to 370 beds, an improved lay-out of hospital facilities with a clear distinction of the Hospital's functional areas, and a new internal circulation system. The present programme under KfW funding addresses the Hospital's most prevalent shortcomings in its key functions. It will provide for new medical and surgical departments, a comprehensive technical services centre and improved support infrastructure and utilities.

### Scope of Services

The objectives of the consulting services are:

- An updated project preparation on the basis of a former study and resulting project appraisal
- Master Plan for the rehabilitation of the Hospital
- Final design of improvement measures and the preparation of the corresponding tender dossier
- Supervision of the tender procedure
- Contract management and supervision of construction works
- Identification of necessary medical equipment, its procurement and installation
