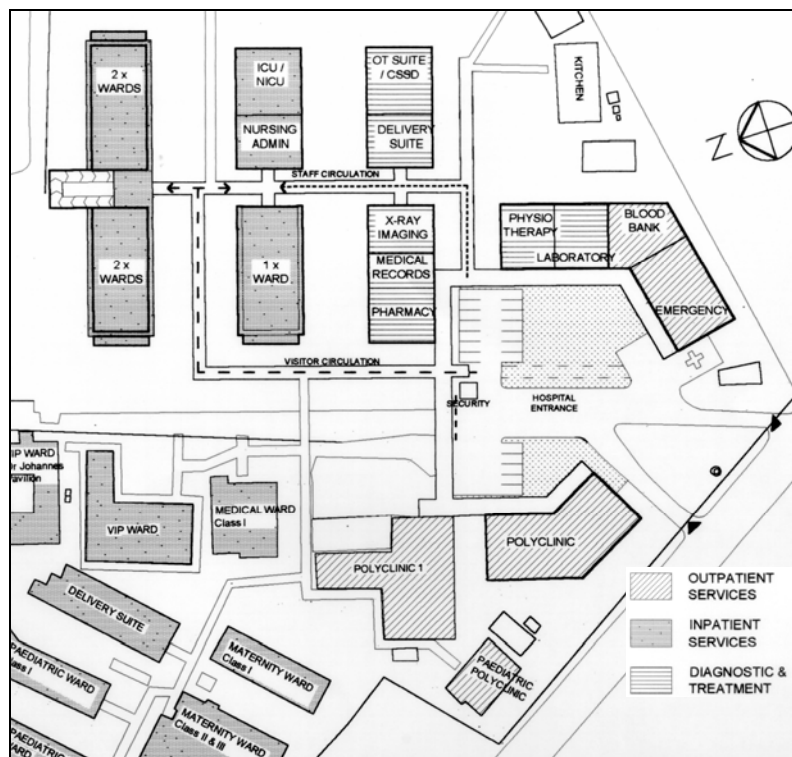

Project Description

Rehabilitation of 13 hospitals in terms of operational and physical improvements, and through the procurement of essential medical and non-medical equipment.

Largely due to the hospitals' remote locations on six islands in Indonesia's eastern-most province, their current situation is far from being satisfactory. The major shortcomings are associated with an inadequate supply with infrastructure and technical services, a rather poor state of hospital buildings and structures, and with limited resources in respect of personnel and equipment.

All rehabilitation measures are identified and discussed in Business Plans which were set up in close cooperation with Client officials and management staff of the respective hospitals.

Scope of Services

Provision of consulting services for the physical improvement component:

- Technical assessment of the hospitals, their technical services and relating off-site infrastructure
- Identification of physical improvements in line with the hospitals' Business Plans
- Establishment of Hospital Master Plans and prioritisation of development measures
- Preparation of a phased implementation schedule covering all 13 hospitals
- Design of improvement measures for the hospitals' buildings and technical services
- Supervision of tendering and contracting of physical works
- Construction supervision, contract management, and acceptance of works
- Budgeting of investments, financial monitoring and reporting
